

English letters are used to show you how to pronounce each syllable. This is called 'phonetics.' Below you will see the English letters used, and the sound they make.

(ending sound of each syllable, but there is a character for each vowel by itself, too)



a (ball)



e (egg)



i (key)



o (phone)



u (shoe)



v (umbrella)

Consonants *(beginning sounds of each syllable)*
